A word before you begin

God is a giver. That is not a slogan. It is the pattern of Scripture from the first page to the last.

He blesses. He multiplies. He provides. He gives rain in its season, and bread for the day, and a Spirit poured out on all flesh. And He does it because giving is what He is like, not because we have finally performed well enough to deserve it.

Now, one word of care before you read. It is possible to take a list like this and quietly reduce God to the things He hands out. Do not do that. The promises here are real and they are worth standing on. But the Giver is better than the gift, every single time.

So turn these verses into prayer. Thank Him for what He has already given. Ask Him for what He has promised. And hold all of it with an open hand, trusting that the Father who did not withhold His own Son can be trusted with everything else.

Themes stated many times across Scripture, such as fruitfulness or provision, are represented with several passages from different books rather than every single occurrence. Scripture quotations are taken from the Berean Standard Bible, which is freely available for use without permission. This is a thorough collection rather than an exhaustive one. If a passage you love is missing, write it in the margin. This copy is yours now.

How to pray this

Start with thanksgiving, always. Before you ask God for a single thing on this list, go back through what He has already given and name it out loud. Gratitude keeps the heart from turning greedy, and it is the doorway He tells us to come through.

Then ask. Plainly, and without embarrassment. He is a Father, and He said to ask. Bring the specific need, the specific bill, the specific healing, the specific gift you are asking Him to stir up in you.

Now hold it with an open hand. Some of these promises were spoken to a nation under a particular covenant, and some are spoken directly to us in Christ. Read them in their setting rather than lifting each one out as a personal guarantee. God is not a mechanism, and prayer is not a lever we pull to make Him move.

So pray them as a son or a daughter rather than as a claimant. Thank Him for what He has given. Ask Him for what He has promised. Trust Him with what He has not yet answered, and keep praying anyway.

And pray them over others. Over your household's provision. Over a friend out of work. Over the gifts God has put in the people around you, that they would be stirred up and not left to sleep.

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Old Testament

GENESIS TO MALACHI

Genesis

GENESIS 1:28

Fruitful, multiply, given dominion

God blessed them and said to them, “Be fruitful and multiply, and fill the earth and subdue it; rule over the fish of the sea and the birds of the air and every creature that crawls upon the earth.”

GENESIS 9:1

Fruitful and multiply, renewed after the flood

And God blessed Noah and his sons and said to them, “Be fruitful and multiply and fill the earth.

GENESIS 12:2-3

Made a great nation, blessed, a blessing to all families of the earth

I will make you into a great nation, and I will bless you; I will make your name great, so that you will be a blessing. I will bless those who bless you and curse those who curse you; and all the families of the earth will be blessed through you.”

GENESIS 13:14-15

Land promised as far as the eye can see, given forever

After Lot had departed, the LORD said to Abram, “Now lift up your eyes from the place where you are, and look to the north and south and east and west, for all the land that you see, I will give to you and your offspring forever.

GENESIS 15:5-6

Seed as the stars, righteousness credited through faith

And the LORD took him outside and said, “Now look to the heavens and count the stars, if you are able.” Then He told him, “So shall your offspring be.” Abram believed the LORD, and it was credited to him as righteousness.

GENESIS 17:4-6**Father of many nations, exceedingly fruitful, kings shall come**

“As for Me, this is My covenant with you: You will be the father of many nations. No longer will you be called Abram, but your name will be Abraham, for I have made you a father of many nations. I will make you exceedingly fruitful; I will make nations of you, and kings will descend from you.

GENESIS 22:17-18**Blessed and multiplied, seed possesses the gate of enemies, all nations blessed**

I will surely bless you, and I will multiply your descendants like the stars in the sky and the sand on the seashore. Your descendants will possess the gates of their enemies. And through your offspring all nations of the earth will be blessed, because you have obeyed My voice.”

GENESIS 26:3-4**Land, presence, and blessing renewed to Isaac**

Stay in this land as a foreigner, and I will be with you and bless you. For I will give all these lands to you and your offspring, and I will confirm the oath that I swore to your father Abraham. I will make your descendants as numerous as the stars in the sky, and I will give them all these lands, and through your offspring all nations of the earth will be blessed,

GENESIS 28:13-15**Land, seed as the dust, blessing to all families, kept and brought back**

And there at the top the LORD was standing and saying, “I am the LORD, the God of your father Abraham and the God of Isaac. I will give you and your descendants the land on which you now lie. Your descendants will be like the dust of the earth, and you will spread out to the west and east and north and south. All the families of the earth will be blessed through you and your offspring. Look, I am with you, and I will watch over you wherever you go, and I will bring you back to this land. For I will not leave you until I have done what I have promised you.”

GENESIS 49:25

Blessings of heaven above and the deep beneath, breasts and womb

by the God of your father who helps you, and by the Almighty who blesses you, with blessings of the heavens above, with blessings of the depths below, with blessings of the breasts and womb.

HOW TO PRAY GENESIS

The promises here begin with fruitfulness and land and descendants, spoken to particular people at a particular time. So read them as the pattern of a God who gives, rather than as a title deed. Thank Him for the ground you have been given, and ask Him to make what is in your hand fruitful.

Leviticus

LEVITICUS 26:3-10

Rain in season, land yields increase, trees yield fruit, peace, fruitfulness, plenty so old store must be moved out

If you follow My statutes and carefully keep My commandments, I will give you rains in their season, and the land will yield its produce, and the trees of the field will bear their fruit. Your threshing will continue until the grape harvest, and the grape harvest will continue until sowing time; you will have your fill of food to eat and will dwell securely in your land. And I will give peace to the land, and you will lie down with nothing to fear. I will rid the land of dangerous animals, and no sword will pass through your land. You will pursue your enemies, and they will fall by the sword before you. Five of you will pursue a hundred, and a hundred of you will pursue ten thousand, and your enemies will fall by the sword before you. I will turn toward you and make you fruitful and multiply you, and I will establish My covenant with you. You will still be eating the old supply of grain when you need to clear it out to make room for the new.

HOW TO PRAY LEVITICUS

Rain in season, and harvest so full that last year's store has to be moved out to make room. Pray it over your work and your household's provision, and thank Him that His giving has never been careful or grudging.

Deuteronomy

DEUTERONOMY 7:13

Loved, blessed, multiplied, fruit of body and ground, corn, wine, oil, increase of cattle

He will love you and bless you and multiply you. He will bless the fruit of your womb and the produce of your land—your grain, new wine, and oil, the young of your herds and the lambs of your flocks—in the land that He swore to your fathers to give you.

DEUTERONOMY 8:18

Given power to get wealth, to establish His covenant

But remember that it is the LORD your God who gives you the power to gain wealth, in order to confirm His covenant that He swore to your fathers even to this day.

DEUTERONOMY 28:2-13

Blessings for obedience: in the city and field, fruit of body/ground/cattle, basket and store, coming in and going out, enemies defeated, blessed storehouses, established as a holy people, plenteous in goods, the head and not the tail

And all these blessings will come upon you and overtake you, if you will obey the voice of the LORD your God: You will be blessed in the city and blessed in the country. The fruit of your womb will be blessed, as well as the produce of your land and the offspring of your livestock—the calves of your herds and the lambs of your flocks. Your basket and kneading bowl will be blessed. You will be blessed when you come in and blessed when you go out. The LORD will cause the enemies who rise up against you to be defeated before you. They will march out against you in one direction but flee from you in seven. The LORD will decree a blessing on your barns and on everything to which you put your hand; the LORD your God will bless you in the land He is giving you. The LORD will establish you as His holy people, just as He has sworn to you, if you keep the commandments of the LORD your God and walk in His ways. Then all the peoples of the earth will see that you are called by the name of the LORD, and they will stand in awe of you. The LORD will make you prosper abundantly—in the fruit of your womb, the offspring of your livestock, and the produce of your land—in the land that the LORD swore to your fathers to give you. The LORD will open the heavens, His abundant storehouse, to send rain on your land in season and to bless all the work of your hands. You will lend to many

nations, but borrow from none. The LORD will make you the head and not the tail; you will only move upward and never downward, if you hear and carefully follow the commandments of the LORD your God, which I am giving you today.

DEUTERONOMY 30:9

Plenteous in every work of the hand, fruit of body, cattle, and land

So the LORD your God will make you abound in all the work of your hands and in the fruit of your womb, the offspring of your livestock, and the produce of your land. Indeed, the LORD will again delight in your prosperity, as He delighted in that of your fathers,

HOW TO PRAY DEUTERONOMY

Blessed in the city and in the field, coming in and going out. Pray these over the ordinary movements of your week. And notice the verse that says it is God who gives the power to get wealth, which keeps our success from becoming our own trophy.

Joshua

JOSHUA 1:8

Prosperity and good success through meditating on the Law

This Book of the Law must not depart from your mouth; meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do everything written in it. For then you will prosper and succeed in all you do.

JOSHUA 21:45

Not one word of all His good promises failed

Not one of all the LORD's good promises to the house of Israel had failed; everything was fulfilled.

HOW TO PRAY JOSHUA

Meditate on His word day and night, and your way will be prosperous. That is the condition, and it is not a transaction so much as a formation. Ask Him for an appetite for Scripture, then thank Him that not one word of His promises has ever failed.

Job

JOB 42:12

Latter end blessed more than the beginning

So the LORD blessed Job's latter days more than his first. He owned 14,000 sheep, 6,000 camels, 1,000 yoke of oxen, and 1,000 female donkeys.

HOW TO PRAY JOB

God blessed the latter end of Job more than his beginning, and He did it after everything had been stripped away. Pray it over a life that feels like it has already had its best years.

Psalms

PSALM 1:1-3

Blessed like a tree planted by rivers of water, fruit in season, prospers

Blessed is the man who does not walk in the counsel of the wicked, or set foot on the path of sinners, or sit in the seat of mockers. But his delight is in the Law of the LORD, and on His law he meditates day and night. He is like a tree planted by streams of water, yielding its fruit in season, whose leaf does not wither, and who prospers in all he does.

PSALM 23:1,6

Shepherd who provides, goodness and mercy follow all the days of life

The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want. [...] Surely goodness and mercy will follow me all the days of my life, and I will dwell in the house of the LORD forever.

PSALM 37:4**Delight in the Lord, desires of the heart given**

Delight yourself in the LORD, and He will give you the desires of your heart.

PSALM 84:11**Sun and shield, grace and glory, no good thing withheld**

For the LORD God is a sun and a shield; the LORD gives grace and glory; He withholds no good thing from those who walk with integrity.

PSALM 103:2-5**His kind deeds: forgiveness, healing, redemption, loving devotion, renewed strength**

Bless the LORD, O my soul, and do not forget all His kind deeds— He who forgives all your iniquities and heals all your diseases, who redeems your life from the Pit and crowns you with loving devotion and compassion, who satisfies you with good things, so that your youth is renewed like the eagle's.

PSALM 112:1-3**Blessed man who fears the Lord, wealth and riches in his house**

Hallelujah! Blessed is the man who fears the LORD, who greatly delights in His commandments. His descendants will be mighty in the land; the generation of the upright will be blessed. Wealth and riches are in his house, and his righteousness endures forever.

PSALM 115:14**Increase more and more, you and your children**

May the LORD give you increase, both you and your children.

PSALM 128:1-4**Blessed, fruitful vine, children like olive plants**

Blessed are all who fear the LORD, who walk in His ways! For when you eat the fruit of your labor, blessings and prosperity will be yours. Your wife will be like a fruitful vine flourishing within your house, your sons like olive shoots sitting around your table. In this way indeed shall blessing come to the man who fears the LORD.

PSALM 132:15**Provision blessed abundantly, poor satisfied with bread**

I will bless her with abundant provisions; I will satisfy her poor with bread.

HOW TO PRAY PSALMS

Delight yourself in the Lord and He will give you the desires of your heart. Notice the order. Ask Him to shape the desires first. Thank Him as your Shepherd who provides, and that no good thing is withheld from those who walk uprightly.

Proverbs

PROVERBS 3:9-10**Honour the Lord with substance, barns filled with plenty**

Honor the LORD with your wealth and with the firstfruits of all your crops; then your barns will be filled with plenty, and your vats will overflow with new wine.

PROVERBS 10:22**The blessing of the Lord makes rich, adds no sorrow**

The blessing of the LORD enriches, and He adds no sorrow to it.

PROVERBS 28:20**A faithful man abounds with blessings**

A faithful man will abound with blessings, but one eager to be rich will not go unpunished.

HOW TO PRAY PROVERBS

The blessing of the Lord makes rich, and He adds no sorrow with it. Pray for increase that does not cost you your family, your health or your peace, because that kind of increase is not from Him.

Isaiah

ISAIAH 1:19

Willing and obedient, eat the good of the land

If you are willing and obedient, you will eat the best of the land.

ISAIAH 55:1-3

Come freely, wine and milk without cost, an everlasting covenant

“Come, all you who are thirsty, come to the waters; and you without money, come, buy, and eat! Come, buy wine and milk without money and without cost! Why spend money on that which is not bread, and your labor on that which does not satisfy? Listen carefully to Me, and eat what is good, and your soul will delight in the richest of foods. Incline your ear and come to Me; listen, so that your soul may live. I will make with you an everlasting covenant— My loving devotion promised to David.

ISAIAH 61:1-3

Good tidings, liberty, the opening of the prison, beauty for ashes, oil of joy, garment of praise

The Spirit of the Lord GOD is on Me, because the LORD has anointed Me to preach good news to the poor. He has sent Me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives and freedom to the prisoners, to proclaim the year of the LORD's favor and the day of our God's vengeance, to comfort all who mourn, to console the mourners in Zion— to give them a crown of beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, and a garment of praise for a spirit of despair. So they will be called oaks of righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that He may be glorified.

ISAIAH 61:7

Double honour instead of shame, everlasting joy

Instead of shame, My people will have a double portion, and instead of humiliation, they will rejoice in their share; and so they will inherit a double portion in their land, and everlasting joy will be theirs.

HOW TO PRAY ISAIAH

Beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness. Pray this exchange over someone in grief. And thank Him for an invitation that costs nothing, come, buy without money.

Jeremiah

JEREMIAH 17:7-8

Blessed, trusts in the Lord, like a tree by the waters

But blessed is the man who trusts in the LORD, whose confidence is in Him. He is like a tree planted by the waters that sends out its roots toward the stream. It does not fear when the heat comes, and its leaves are always green. It does not worry in a year of drought, nor does it cease to produce fruit.

JEREMIAH 31:12

Flow to the goodness of the Lord: wheat, wine, oil, flocks, herds, a watered garden, sorrow no more

They will come and shout for joy on the heights of Zion; they will be radiant over the bounty of the LORD— the grain, new wine, and oil, and the young of the flocks and herds. Their life will be like a well-watered garden, and never again will they languish.

JEREMIAH 33:6

Health, cure, abundance of peace and truth revealed

Nevertheless, I will bring to it health and healing, and I will heal its people and reveal to them the abundance of peace and truth.

HOW TO PRAY JEREMIAH

Blessed is the one who trusts in the Lord, like a tree planted by the waters, whose leaf stays green in drought. Ask Him for roots that go deep enough that the dry season does not decide your fruitfulness.

Ezekiel

EZEKIEL 34:26

Showers of blessing

I will make them and the places around My hill a blessing. I will send down showers in season—showers of blessing.

EZEKIEL 36:29-30

Delivered from uncleanness, corn increased, fruit multiplied, no more famine

I will save you from all your uncleanness. I will summon the grain and make it plentiful, and I will not bring famine upon you. I will also make the fruit of the trees and the crops of the field plentiful, so that you will no longer bear reproach among the nations on account of famine.

HOW TO PRAY EZEKIEL

Showers of blessing, and no more famine. Pray it over a season that has been thin, and thank Him that He restores rather than merely stops the loss.

Joel

JOEL 2:25-26

The years the locust ate restored, eat in plenty and be satisfied

I will repay you for the years eaten by locusts— the swarming locust, the young locust, the destroying locust, and the devouring locust— My great army that I sent against you. You will have plenty to eat, until you are satisfied. You will praise the name of the LORD your God, who has worked wonders for you. My people will never again be put to shame.

HOW TO PRAY JOEL

He restores the years the locust has eaten. Pray it over wasted time. Over the years lost to an addiction, an illness or a wrong turn. He gives back what was consumed.

Malachi

MALACHI 3:10-11

The full tithe, the windows of heaven opened, blessing without measure, the devourer rebuked

Bring the full tithe into the storehouse, so that there may be food in My house. Test Me in this,” says the LORD of Hosts. “See if I will not open the windows of heaven and pour out for you blessing without measure. I will rebuke the devourer for you, so that it will not destroy the fruits of your land, and the vine in your field will not fail to produce fruit,” says the LORD of Hosts.

HOW TO PRAY MALACHI

Bring the full tithe and see if He will not open the windows of heaven. This is the one place God invites us to test Him. Pray over your giving before you give, and give without trying to calculate the return.



New Testament

MATTHEW TO REVELATION

Matthew

MATTHEW 6:33

Seek first the kingdom, all things added

But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things will be added unto you.

MATTHEW 7:7-11

Ask, seek, knock; good gifts given to those who ask

Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and the door will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives; he who seeks finds; and to him who knocks, the door will be opened. Which of you, if his son asks for bread, will give him a stone? Or if he asks for a fish, will give him a snake? So if you who are evil know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give good things to those who ask Him!

MATTHEW 13:23

Good ground bears fruit a hundredfold

But the seed sown on good soil is the one who hears the word and understands it. He indeed bears fruit and produces a crop—a hundredfold, sixtyfold, or thirtyfold.”

MATTHEW 19:29

Hundredfold return, and inherit everlasting life

And everyone who has left houses or brothers or sisters or father or mother or wife or children or fields for the sake of My name will receive a hundredfold and will inherit eternal life.

HOW TO PRAY MATTHEW

Seek first the kingdom, and all these things shall be added. Pray for the seeking to come first and the adding to follow, rather than the other way round. Then ask, seek and knock about the specific thing, because He told you to.

Mark

MARK 10:29-30

Hundredfold now in this life, with persecutions, and eternal life in the world to come

“Truly I tell you,” Jesus replied, “no one who has left home or brothers or sisters or mother or father or children or fields for My sake and for the gospel will fail to receive a hundredfold in the present age—houses and brothers and sisters and mothers and children and fields, along with persecutions—and in the age to come, eternal life.

HOW TO PRAY MARK

A hundredfold now in this life, with persecutions. Do not skip the last two words. Thank Him for a generosity that is honest about the cost of following Him.

Luke

LUKE 6:38

Give and it shall be given, good measure, pressed down, shaken together, running over

Give, and it will be given to you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over will be poured into your lap. For with the measure you use, it will be measured back to you.”

HOW TO PRAY LUKE

Give, and it shall be given to you, pressed down, shaken together and running over. Pray it as you plan your giving, and ask Him for a generous spirit rather than a calculating one.

John

JOHN 1:16

Of His fulness we have all received, grace for grace

From His fullness we have all received grace upon grace.

JOHN 4:14

A well of water springing up into everlasting life

But whoever drinks the water I give him will never thirst. Indeed, the water I give him will become in him a fount of water springing up to eternal life.”

JOHN 6:35

Bread of life, never hunger or thirst

Jesus answered, “I am the bread of life. Whoever comes to Me will never hunger, and whoever believes in Me will never thirst.

JOHN 7:38

Rivers of living water flowing out of the believer

Whoever believes in Me, as the Scripture has said: ‘Streams of living water will flow from within him.’”

JOHN 10:10

Life, and that more abundantly

The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy. I have come that they may have life, and have it in all its fullness.

JOHN 14:27**Peace given, His own peace, not as the world gives**

Peace I leave with you; My peace I give to you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled; do not be afraid.

JOHN 15:11**His joy remaining in us, joy full**

I have told you these things so that My joy may be in you and your joy may be complete.

JOHN 16:24**Ask and receive, that joy may be full**

Until now you have not asked for anything in My name. Ask and you will receive, so that your joy may be complete.

HOW TO PRAY JOHN

Rivers of living water. Life more abundantly. His own peace, not as the world gives. Ask Him for the abundance He actually promised, which is Himself, and let the rest come as it comes.

Acts

ACTS 3:19**Times of refreshing from the presence of the Lord**

Repent, then, and turn back, so that your sins may be wiped away,

HOW TO PRAY ACTS

Times of refreshing come from the presence of the Lord. So when you are dry, the answer is not a better technique. Ask for His presence and thank Him that refreshing is found there.

Romans

ROMANS 4:16

Promise sure to all the seed, of faith

Therefore, the promise comes by faith, so that it may rest on grace and may be guaranteed to all Abraham's offspring—not only to those who are of the law, but also to those who are of the faith of Abraham. He is the father of us all.

ROMANS 8:32

Freely given all things with Christ

He who did not spare His own Son but gave Him up for us all, how will He not also, along with Him, freely give us all things?

ROMANS 11:29

God's gifts and His call are irrevocable

For God's gifts and His call are irrevocable.

ROMANS 12:6-8

Gifts differing according to grace: prophecy, ministry, teaching, exhortation, giving, ruling, showing mercy

We have different gifts according to the grace given us. If one's gift is prophecy, let him use it in proportion to his faith; if it is serving, let him serve; if it is teaching, let him teach; if it is encouraging, let him encourage; if it is giving, let him give generously; if it is leading, let him lead with diligence; if it is showing mercy, let him do it cheerfully.

HOW TO PRAY ROMANS

He freely gives us all things with Christ. Thank Him that the greatest gift is already given, which settles the question of whether He is willing. Then ask Him to stir up the particular grace gift He has placed in you.

1 Corinthians

1 CORINTHIANS 2:9

What God has prepared for those who love Him, beyond eye, ear or imagination

Rather, as it is written: “No eye has seen, no ear has heard, no heart has imagined, what God has prepared for those who love Him.”

1 CORINTHIANS 12:4-11

Diversities of gifts, one Spirit: wisdom, knowledge, faith, healing, miracles, prophecy, discerning of spirits, tongues, interpretation

There are different gifts, but the same Spirit. There are different ministries, but the same Lord. There are different ways of working, but the same God works all things in all people. Now to each one the manifestation of the Spirit is given for the common good. To one there is given through the Spirit the message of wisdom, to another the message of knowledge by the same Spirit, to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healing by that one Spirit, to another the working of miracles, to another prophecy, to another distinguishing between spirits, to another speaking in various tongues, and to still another the interpretation of tongues. All these are the work of one and the same Spirit, who apportions them to each one as He determines.

HOW TO PRAY 1 CORINTHIANS

Eye has not seen what God has prepared for those who love Him. Worship Him for what you cannot yet imagine. Then ask honestly for the gifts of the Spirit, and ask for them to serve the room rather than to mark you out.

2 Corinthians

2 CORINTHIANS 8:9

Christ became poor, that we through His poverty might be rich

For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though He was rich, yet for your sakes He became poor, so that you through His poverty might become rich.

2 CORINTHIANS 9:10-11

Seed for the sower multiplied, fruits of righteousness increased, enriched in everything to bountifulness

Now He who supplies seed to the sower and bread for food will supply and multiply your store of seed and will increase the harvest of your righteousness. You will be enriched in every way to be generous on every occasion, and through us your generosity will produce thanksgiving to God.

2 CORINTHIANS 9:15

Thanks be to God for His unspeakable gift

Thanks be to God for His indescribable gift!

HOW TO PRAY 2 CORINTHIANS

He multiplies seed to the sower. Pray it over what you have sown, in money and in years. And thank Him for the unspeakable gift, the one that never needed asking for.

Galatians

GALATIANS 3:14

The blessing of Abraham, the promise of the Spirit through faith

He redeemed us in order that the blessing promised to Abraham would come to the Gentiles in Christ Jesus, so that by faith we might receive the promise of the Spirit.

HOW TO PRAY GALATIANS

The blessing of Abraham comes to us through Christ, and with it the promise of the Spirit through faith. Thank Him that you were grafted in, and that nothing about your background disqualifies you.

Ephesians

EPHESIANS 2:7

Exceeding riches of His grace, kindness toward us in Christ

in order that in the coming ages He might display the surpassing riches of His grace, demonstrated by His kindness to us in Christ Jesus.

EPHESIANS 3:8

The unsearchable riches of Christ

Though I am less than the least of all the saints, this grace was given me: to preach to the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ,

EPHESIANS 4:7-8

Grace given according to the measure of Christ's gift; gifts given to men

Now to each one of us grace has been given according to the measure of the gift of Christ. This is why it says: "When He ascended on high, He led captives away, and gave gifts to men."

EPHESIANS 4:11

Gave apostles, prophets, evangelists, pastors and teachers

And it was He who gave some to be apostles, some to be prophets, some to be evangelists, and some to be pastors and teachers,

HOW TO PRAY EPHESIANS

The exceeding riches of His grace, and the unsearchable riches of Christ. Pray for the gifts He has given to His church, and ask Him to raise up the ones our house still needs.

1 Timothy

1 TIMOTHY 6:17

God who gives us richly all things to enjoy

Instruct those who are rich in the present age not to be conceited and not to put their hope in the uncertainty of wealth, but in God, who richly provides all things for us to enjoy.

HOW TO PRAY 1 TIMOTHY

He gives us richly all things to enjoy. Thank Him for the ordinary good things of your life, by name, and let yourself actually enjoy them without guilt.

2 Timothy

2 TIMOTHY 1:6

The gift of God within, stirred up

For this reason I remind you to fan into flame the gift of God, which is in you through the laying on of my hands.

HOW TO PRAY 2 TIMOTHY

Stir up the gift of God which is in you. Ask Him to wake up what has gone quiet, and then act on it, because stirring up is something we are told to do.

James

JAMES 1:5

Wisdom given liberally to those who ask

Now if any of you lacks wisdom, he should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to him.

JAMES 1:17

Every good and perfect gift comes down from the Father of lights

Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights, with whom there is no change or shifting shadow.

HOW TO PRAY JAMES

If any of you lacks wisdom, ask. Pray it over the decision in front of you this week, and thank Him that every good and perfect gift comes down from a Father who does not change.

1 Peter

1 PETER 4:10

Every man has received a gift, to minister as good stewards

As good stewards of the manifold grace of God, each of you should use whatever gift he has received to serve one another.

HOW TO PRAY 1 PETER

Every one of us has received a gift, to be used as good stewards. Ask Him to show you yours, and ask for the humility to use it for others rather than for your own standing.

1 John

1 JOHN 3:22

Whatsoever we ask, we receive

and we will receive from Him whatever we ask, because we keep His commandments and do what is pleasing in His sight.

HOW TO PRAY 1 JOHN

Whatever we ask, we receive of Him, because we keep His commandments and do the things pleasing in His sight. Read the whole sentence, and let it shape the asking rather than only the expecting.

3 John

3 JOHN 1:2

Wish above all things that you may prosper and be in health

Beloved, I pray that in every way you may prosper and enjoy good health, as your soul also prospers.

HOW TO PRAY 3 JOHN

That you may prosper and be in health, even as your soul prospers. Pray it over your family, and notice that the measure is the soul. Ask Him to prosper that first.

Revelation

REVELATION 21:6

Fountain of the water of life, given freely

And He told me, "It is done! I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End. To the thirsty I will give freely from the spring of the water of life.

REVELATION 22:17

Whosoever will, let him take the water of life freely

The Spirit and the bride say, “Come!” Let the one who hears say, “Come!” And let the one who is thirsty come, and the one who desires the water of life drink freely.

HOW TO PRAY REVELATION

Let the one who is thirsty come and take the water of life freely. That is where the whole Bible lands. Thank Him that the last invitation in Scripture costs nothing, and pray it over anyone you are longing to see come.



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
